**Expression of interest: Establishing a working group on mHealth assessment guidelines**

**Stockholm University would like to express interest in participating in establishing a working group on mHealth assessment guidelines. We would like to nominate Professor Per Carlbring.**

The University's researchers are engaged in all aspects of society, and participate in governmental working parties, in the media, as consultants for proposed legislation, in the Nobel committees and in international expert bodies.

We would like to nominate Professor Per Carlbring, who is a prominent researcher in his field. He is a psychologist and a psychotherapist and has a strong interest in and also excellent qualifications for this particular call.

Professor Carlbring has carried out research in the eMental and mMental fields since 1999 and has published more than 150 peer-reviewed papers in this domain. He is a founding member of the European Society for Research on Internet Interventions (ESRII) and the International Society for Research on Internet Interventions (ISRII). This makes him very well connected within the eMental and mMental health community. ESRII and ISRII are non-profit interdisciplinary organizations committed to studying eHealth/mHealth interventions and information as well as communication technologies targeting behavioral and mental health. Professor Carlbring is also an advisory board member of the E-COMPARED consortium. The E-COMPARED was funded by the European Commission to conduct research on the clinical- and cost-effectiveness of blended depression treatment using smartphones.

We believe that Professor Carlbring will be an excellent asset to the working group on mHealth assessment guidelines.
